

Special Weed Assessment Meeting

For Round Lake

January 5, 2018 at 5:00 PM

-Meeting called to order at 5:07pm by Supervisor David.

-Roll call: Sayre-yes, Willett-yes, David-yes and Combs-yes. Trustee Walker was absent. Quorum has been reached.

-Opening Statement by Supervisor David:

This is a hearing of necessity to renew the Special Assessment District for Round Lake and must be done by law. The renewal is for 5 years. The estimated annual cost to treat the lake is \$20,100 which would be \$55.00 per lake front lot. This meeting is to hear resident concerns if we should set up weed assessment district. We have provided a sheet with the rationale for establishing assessments. Tonight we will set up a district or not.

-Steve Hanson from PLM Lake & Land Management Corp. gave a presentation on treating the lakes and the condition of the lakes. PLM has managed the weed program for seven years. According to Steve there are a lot of different kinds of weeds that are not native. Steve was available for questions from our residents.

Citizen comments:

-Arlen Miller-We should continue with the weed assessment.

-Board comments: Clerk Combs commented that the weed problem is in control and continuing the Special assessment district will allow us to retain control.

-Supervisor David took a vote of residents that were present, as to if they agree or disagree to re-establishing the weed assessment district? 4 – yes and 0 no.

-Resolution 2018-2 Round Lake Weed Abatement Special Assessment District following first public hearing. Motion by Willett and supported by Sayre, roll call: Sayre-yes, Willett-yes, Combs-yes, and David-yes. No nays. Resolution passed.

-Next meetings will be held on January 23, 2018 at 4:00pm for Devils Lake and at 5:00pm for Round Lake in order to hear objections to the assessment roll.

-Supervisor David adjourn meeting at 5:25pm.
