Typed copy of 5/26/1881, and 2/17/1882 Rollin Township Board of Health meeting minutes.

In the matter of the proposition of Orson Green to deed to the Board of health of the aboved named township and their successors in office, so much land as said Board shall deem sufficient for a burying ground including the ground now used on his premises for such purpose.

On resolution of N.M. Pattison the proposition was accepted, yeas, three, nays none.

On resolution offered by H. S. Bowen. It was decided to have the burying ground known as Belcher Hill deeded to the township Board of health and their successors in office, if possible and the ground enlarged on the East and West.

On resolution offered by H S Bowen, It was decided
to have the burying Ground known as Belcher Hill
deeded to the township Board of health and their
successors in office, if possible and the ground enlarged
on the East and west Yeas Pattison & Raymond
Nays, none.

On resolution J W B Town was appointed a committee to work the
matter up.
